IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Trade and Industry by section 3 of the Control of Goods, Prices and Other Charges Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods (Import and Export of Agricultural Products) (Amendment) Regulations, 2005.

2. The Control of Goods (Import and Export of Agricultural Products) Regulations are amended in regulation 5 thereof by substituting, for subregulation (2), the following new subregulation —

“Any person applying for an import permit under these Regulations shall produce, to the authorised officer, such information or documents as the officer may require, proving that at least —

(a) 50% of the maize meal, samp or animal feed for poultry and livestock; or

(b) 40% of the sorghum grains, sorghum meal, sorghum rice or any other processed sorghum product,

which is the subject of his or her application, was obtained in Botswana.”.
