ARRANGEMENT OF BYE-LAWS

BYE-LAW

1. Citation
2. Amendment of Bye-law 8 of Cap. 40:02 (Sub. Leg.)
3. Amendment of Bye-law 32 of the Bye-laws
4. Amendment of Bye-law 36(1) of the Bye-laws

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Townships Act, and with the approval of the Minister of Local Government, the Lobatse Town Council hereby makes the following Bye-laws —

Citation 1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Lobatse Town Council (General) (Amendment) Bye-laws, 2005.

Amendment of
bye-law 8
of Cap. 40:02
(Sub. Leg.) 2. The Lobatse Town Council (General) Bye-laws are amended by substituting
bye-law 8 thereof, the following new bye-law —

“Keeping of 8 (1) No person shall keep or graze any livestock in the council area.
livestock (2) Unless authorised to do so by the Council, no person shall
use any stable or site in the council area.

(3) Any person who fails to comply with bye-law 8 commits
an offence and is liable —

(a) in the case of an offence against sub-bye-law (1), to a
fine of P200,00, or, in default of payment thereof, to
imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months; and

(b) in the case of an offence against sub-bye-law (2), to a fine
of P100,00, or, in default of payment thereof, to imprisonment
for a term not exceeding three months.”

Amendment of
bye-law 32
of the Bye-laws 3. Bye-law 32 is amended by inserting —

(a) the words “(1)” immediately after the words “32”;

(b) immediately after “(e)” the following new sub-bye-law —

“(2) Any person who fails to comply with the provisions of bye-law 32
commits an offence and is liable on first conviction to a fine of P150,00,
or, in default of payment thereof, to imprisonment for a term not
exceeding four months, and for any subsequent conviction to a fine of
P200,00, or, in default of payment thereof, to imprisonment for a term
not exceeding six months.”.

4. Bye-law 36 (1) is amended by deleting the words “8 (1)” and the words “32” which appear therein. Amendment of
bye-law 36
of the Bye-laws
