ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

PARAGRAPH

1. Citation
2. Delegation of powers to prosecute
3. Powers to be exercised subject to directions

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on her by section 8 of the Criminal Procedure and Evidence Act, the Director of Public Prosecutions hereby makes the following Order —

1. This Order may be cited as the Powers to Prosecute (Delegation) Order, 2005. Citation
2. The powers of the Director of Public Prosecutions to appear at preparatory examinations held under Part VIII of the Act, and to prosecute before all subordinate courts of Botswana are hereby delegated to officers of the Directorate on Corruption and Economic Crime who hold, or are above, the following ranks — Delegation of powers to prosecute
 - (a) Principal Anti Corruption Assistant;
 - (b) Assistant Anti Corruption Officer; or
 - (c) Anti Corruption Technical Officer on salary scale C3.
3. The powers delegated in paragraph 2 shall be exercised subject to the directions given by the Director of Public Prosecutions from time to time. Powers to be exercised subject to directions
