ARRANGEMENT OF BYE-LAWS

BYE-LAW

1. Citation
2. Amendment of bye-law 4 of the Selebi-Phikwe (Abattoir) Bye-Laws

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by regulation 34 of the Town Councils Regulations, and with the approval of the Minister of Local Government, the Selebi-Phikwe Town Council hereby makes the following Bye-Laws —

1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the Selebi-Phikwe Town Council (Abattoir) Bye-Laws, 2005. Citation
2. The Selebi-Phikwe Town Council (Abattoir) Bye-Laws (hereinafter referred to as the "Bye-Laws" are amended by substituting for the words "12.00 noon and 5 p.m" appearing under bye-law 4 (1) (a) thereof, the words "10.00 a.m and 6.30 p.m". Amendment of bye-law 4 of the Selebi-Phikwe (Abattoir) Bye-Laws
3. The Bye-Laws are amended by substituting for the Schedule, the following new Schedule — Amendment of the Schedule

SCHEDULE

1. Use of abattoir for slaughtering including lairage water, inspection and stamping of meat shall be as follows —

(a)	beast	P40.00
(b)	goat	P12.00
(c)	sheep	P12.00
(d)	pig	P20.00

2. Charges per day for use of freezer

(a)	beast	P15.00
(b)	pig	P9.00
(c)	goat	P6.00
(d)	sheep	P6.00

3. Other charges

(a)	detention	P15
(b)	delivery	P20 per trip
