(1) Without prejudice to the provisions of regulation 15, a land board may cancel a grant of customary right to use land for, arable farming, a borehole, or residential purposes if, after the expiration of 5 years from the date of the grant, the land has not been developed without sufficient excuse to the satisfaction of the land board.”.</p> |
