IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Lands and Housing by section 37 of the Tribal Land Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

Citation	<b>1. These Regulations may be cited as the Tribal Land (Subordinate Land Boards) (Amendment) Regulations, 2005.</b>
Insertion of new regulation 16A into Cap. 32:02 (Sub. Leg.)	<b>2. The Tribal Land (Subordinate Land Board) Regulations are amended by inserting, immediately after regulation 16 thereof, the following new regulation —</b>
“Cancellation of customary land rights for failure to develop land	<b>16A. (1) A subordinate land board may recommend to the land board a cancellation of a grant of a customary right to use land for, arable farming, a borehole, or residential purposes if, after the expiration of 5 years from the date of the grant, the land has not been developed without sufficient excuse to the satisfaction of the subordinate land board.”</b>
