ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation
2. Amendment of regulation 3 of Cap. 08:02 (Sub.Leg.)
3. Insertion of regulations 4A and 4B into the Regulations

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister for Presidential Affairs and Public Administration by section 209(3) of the Criminal Procedure and Evidence Act, the following Regulations are made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Tariff of Allowances (Witnesses in Criminal Cases) (Amendment) Regulations, 2006. Citation

2. Regulation 3 of the Tariff of Allowances (Witnesses in Criminal Cases) Regulations (hereinafter referred to as “the Regulations”) is amended — Amendment of regulation 3 of Cap. 08:02 (Sub.Leg.)

- (a) in subregulation (1) (a) thereof, by substituting, for the amount “P250” which appears therein, the amount “P365”;
- (b) in subregulation (1) (b) thereof, by substituting, for the amount “P200” which appears therein, the amount “P300”;
- (c) in subregulation (1) (c) thereof, by substituting, for the amount “P100” which appears therein, the amount “P150”;
- (d) in subregulation (1)(d) thereof, by substituting, for the amount “P75” which appears therein, the amount “P110”;
- (e) in subregulation (1)(e) thereof by substituting, for the amount “P60” which appears therein, the amount “P90”; and
- (f) by inserting, immediately after subregulation (4), the following new subregulation —

“(5) Where a person is called for precognition he or she shall be paid an allowance at the rate of the category of the witnesses to which he or she belongs as prescribed in paragraphs (a) to (e) or as the Registrar may direct.”.

3. The Regulations are amended by inserting, immediately after regulation 4 the following new regulations - Insertion of regulations 4A and 4B into the Regulations

“Overnight accommodation allowance 4A. Where a witness has necessarily incurred the expense of overnight accommodation, an additional amount shall be payable at the same rates as those applicable to members of the public service travelling on duty.”

“Refund of
witnesses

4B. When a journey is performed by air or rail, a refund shall be made for a fare of such class as the witness might ordinarily be expected to travel.”.
