ARRANGEMENT OF BYE-LAWS

BYE-LAW

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on it by section 6 as read with section 6 (a) of the Townships Act, and with the approval of the Minister of Local Government, the Francistown City Council hereby makes the following Bye-Laws —

1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the Francistown City Council (2007/2008) Rating Bye-Laws, 2007. Citation
2. The property rates payable in Francistown for the period 2007/2008 shall be at the rate of — Levy of rates
 - (a) 1,14 thebe in the Pula in respect of all improved rateable land used for residential purposes, and 1,43 thebe in the Pula in respect of all improved rateable land used for industrial or commercial purposes;
 - (b) 4,58 thebe in the Pula in respect of all unimproved rateable land used for residential purposes, and 5,72 thebe in the Pula in respect of all unimproved rateable land used for industrial or commercial purposes; and
 - (c) 0,105 thebe in the Pula in respect of all improved rateable land used for agricultural purposes, and 0,42 thebe in the Pula in respect of all unimproved rateable land used for agricultural purposes.
3. The rates in Bye-Law 2 shall become payable, by the person liable to pay such rates, at the commencement of these Bye-Laws. When rates payable
