ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

PARAGRAPH

2. Prescribed securities

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Finance and Development Planning by section 105 read with paragraph (e) of section 2 of the Non-Bank Financial Institutions Regulatory Authority Act, 2006, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order may be cited as the Non-Bank Financial Institutions Regulatory Authority (Prescribed Securities) Order, 2008. Citation

2. For the purposes of the definition of “securities” in paragraph (e) of section 2 of the Act, the following instruments are hereby prescribed — Prescribed securities

- (a) instruments traded on a commodities exchange licensed under the Act, which shall include —
 - (i) derivative contracts; and
 - (ii) futures or options on any commodity, property, goods, index, interest or other rate, security, currency or future, which may be settled by either physical delivery or cash.
