SCHEDULE

An Act to authorise the payment out of the Consolidated Fund to meet expenditure incurred during the year ending 31st March, 2008.

Date of Assent: 20th April, 2009

Date of Commencement: 24th April, 2009

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (2007/2008) Act, 2009.

Short title

2. (1) The Consolidated Fund is hereby charged with a further sum of P259,976,344 (two hundred and fifty nine million, nine hundred and seventy six thousand, three hundred and forty four pula) to meet expenditure incurred during the financial year, which ended on 31st March, 2008, in excess of the amount already appropriated for the services for that year, which excess is arrived at by taking into account —

- (a) amount already appropriated under the appropriation (2007/2008) Act, 2007;
- (b) actual expenditure of the organisations of expenditure in excess of the amount already appropriated; and
- (c) amounts making up the aggregate of P259,976,344 which is now being appropriated.

(2) The particulars of the excess of the amount already appropriated are set forth in the Schedule hereto.
