

CONSTITUTION OF BOTSWANA

Appointment of Session of Parliament

PROCLAMATION

HIS EXCELLENCY LT. GENERAL SERETSE KHAMA IAN KHAMA,
PH, FOM, DCO, DSM, MP,
PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF BOTSWANA

WHEREAS it is provided by section 90 (1) of the Constitution that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Botswana and shall commence at such time as the President may appoint;

AND WHEREAS it is further provided by section 90 (3) of the Constitution that whenever Parliament is dissolved a general election of the Elected Members of the National Assembly shall be held within 60 days of the date of the dissolution and a session of Parliament shall be appointed to commence within 30 days of that general election;

AND WHEREAS Parliament was dissolved on the 21st day of August, 2009 and a General Election of Elected Members of the National Assembly was held on the 16th day of October, 2009;

NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 90 (1) of the Constitution, I, Lt. General Seretse Khama Ian Khama, President of the Republic of Botswana do hereby declare, proclaim and make known that a session of Parliament shall be held at the Parliament House, Gaborone, commencing at 8:30 o'clock in the morning on the 21st day October, 2009.
