1. Short title and commencement
2. Amendment of section 49 of Cap. 01:04

An Act to amend the Interpretation Act

Date of assent: 19th August, 2010

Date of commencement: On Notice

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the Interpretation (Amendment) Act, 2010 and shall come into operation on such date as the Minister may, by Order, appoint.

Short title and commencement

2. The Interpretation Act is amended in section 49 by substituting for the definitions of 'age of majority' and 'minor' respectively, the following new definitions —

Amendment of section 49 of Cap. 01:04

- a.* "age of majority" means when a person has attained the age of 18 years; and
b. "minor" means a person who has not attained the age of 18 years."
