IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Trade and Industry by section 3 (2) (d) of the Control of Goods, Prices and Other Charges Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

| 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods (National Electrification (Levy)) Regulations, 2010 and shall come into force on 1st April, 2010.  | Citation and commencement                              |
| 2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires —<br>“Department” means the Department of Energy within the Ministry of Minerals, Energy and Water Resources; and<br>“National Electrification Fund” means the Fund established under the National Electrification Fund Order.  | Interpretation   |
| 3. (1) Botswana Power Corporation shall pay a levy at a rate of five thebe per kilo-watt-hour of electricity sold.<br>(2) The levy payable by the Botswana Power Corporation in subregulation (1) shall be charged to the end users of electricity.  | S.I. No. 27 of 2010<br>Levy on electricity consumption |
| 4. The value for the purpose of assessing the levy on electricity consumption shall be the kilo-watt-hours sold multiplied by the value of the levy.   | Calculation of value of levy                           |
| 5. (1) The levy under regulation 3 shall be collected by the Botswana Power Corporation and transferred to the Department and the levy so transferred shall be paid over by the Department to the National Electrification Fund.<br>(2) The manner of utilising the levy shall be as in the Order establishing the National Electrification Fund.                            | Fund into which levy is payable<br>S.I. | 6. These Regulations shall not apply to —<br>(a) electricity sold for purposes of bulk supply in accordance with the Electricity Supply Act;<br>(b) electricity exported in accordance with the Electricity Supply Act; and<br>(c) electricity that is not supplied through electricity facilities owned by the Government of Botswana or by the Botswana Power Corporation. | Application of Regulations<br>Cap. 73:01               |
