ARRANGEMENT OF BYE-LAWS

BYE-LAWS

1. Citation
2. Amendment of Bye-law 4 of Cap. 40:01 (Sub. Leg.)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on it by section 33 of the Local Government (District Councils) Act, and with the approval of the Minister of Local Government, the Ghanzi District Council hereby makes the following Bye-laws —

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Ghanzi District Council (Noise and Nuisance) (Amendment) Bye-laws, 2010. Citation
2. The Ghanzi District Council (Noise and Nuisance) Bye-laws are amended by substituting for Bye-law 4, the following new Bye-law — Amendment of
Bye-law 4 of
Cap. 40:01
(Sub. Leg.)
 - “4. Any person who fails to comply with these Bye-laws shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding P500 or, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding fourteen days, and on a second or subsequent conviction, to a fine not exceeding P2000 or, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two months.”
