| <p>1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Kgatleg District Council (Control of Livestock and Other Animals) (Amendment) Bye-laws, 2010.</p>   | Citation                                  |
| <p>2. Bye-law 2 of the Kgatleg District Council (Control of Livestock and Other Animals) Bye-laws (hereinafter referred to as the "Bye-laws") is amended by inserting in alphabetical sequence the following definitions —<br/>"authorised official" means a person authorised by the Council Secretary, in writing, to give effect to or enforce these Bye-laws;<br/>"Council Officer" means the Council Secretary, the Council Treasurer, Bye-law Enforcement Officer and any other authorised official;<br/>"herdboy" means council employee so authorised to drive astray, wandering or reported animals or detain them into council kraals;<br/>"village area" means any village within the Kgatleg District Council; and<br/>"police officer" means any member of the Botswana Police Service.</p> | Amendment of bye-law 2 of S.I. 23 of 1980 |
| <p>3. Bye-law 3 is amended in paragraph (1) by inserting the words "or kraal" immediately after the word "stable".</p>   | Amendment of bye-law 3 of the Bye-laws    |

Bye-law 8 is amended by inserting —<br/>(a) in paragraph (1) immediately after —<br/>    (i) the word "stable" the word "kraal",<br/>    (ii) the words "upon production of certified identity documents, and," immediately after the word "livestock"; and<br/>(b) in paragraph (2) by inserting the words "or kraal" immediately after the word "stable".</p>  | Amendment of bye-law 8 of the Bye-laws    |

5. The Bye-laws are amended by inserting immediately after Bye-law 4 the following new Bye-law —

“Period of 4A. Any livestock detained under these Bye-laws shall, if  
detention of not claimed within seven days, be handed over to a  
livestock matimela kraal in terms of the Matimela Act.”

6. Bye-law 9 is amended by substituting for the words —

- (a) “P10” the words “P2 000”;
- (b) “seven days”, the words “six months”;
- (c) “P25”, the words “P5 000”; and
- (d) “one month” the words “one year”.

**“SECOND SCHEDULE  
COUNCIL STABLE AND KRAAL FEES  
(bye-law 8)**

<i>Animals</i>	<i>Fee</i>
Sheep, goat and pig	P5 per head per day
Cattle, donkey, mule and horse	P10 per head per day
Other animals	P2 per head per day.”
