PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 90 (1) of the Constitution of Botswana that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Botswana and shall commence at such time as the President may appoint;

AND WHEREAS it is appropriate time to appoint a session of Parliament;

NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 90 (1) of the Constitution, I, SERETSE KHAMA IAN KHAMA, President of the Republic of Botswana, hereby declare, proclaim and make known that a session of Parliament shall be held at the Parliament House, Gaborone, commencing at 2:30 o'clock in the afternoon of the 8th day of November, 2010.
