PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 91 (1) of the Constitution of Botswana that the President may at any time prorogue Parliament;

AND WHEREAS it is considered that this is a convenient and appropriate time to prorogue Parliament;

NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by the said section 91 (1) of the Constitution, I, SERETSE KHAMA IAN KHAMA, President of the Republic of Botswana, hereby declare, proclaim and make known that Parliament shall be prorogued on the 22nd October, 2010.
