ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation
2. Amendment of Cap. 25:02 (Sub. Leg.)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Labour and Home Affairs by section 60 of the Immigration Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Visa) (Amendment) Regulations, 2012. Citation

2. The Immigration (Visa) Regulations are amended in regulation 4 by substituting for subregulation (2), the following new subregulation — Amendment
of Cap. 25:02
(Sub. Leg.)

“(2) A continuous visa shall be a visa authorizing the holder to enter Botswana on an unlimited number of occasions within a period of 36 months from the date of the grant of the visa.”
