SECTION

1. Short title and commencement
2. Amendment of Schedule to Cap. 02:06

An Act to amend the National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) Act.

Date of Assent: 04.10.2013

Date of Commencement: 1st October, 2012

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) (Amendment) Act, 2013, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st October, 2012. Short title and commencement

2. The Schedule to the National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) Act is amended by substituting for paragraph 1, the following new paragraph — Amendment of Schedule to Cap. 02:06

“Salary

1. Every Member shall receive a salary which shall, except in the case of the Government Whip, the Opposition Whip and any other Member, include the responsibility allowance, calculated, in the case of —

- (a) the President, at the rate of P498,828 per annum;
- (b) the Vice President, at the rate of P383,736 per annum;
- (c) a Minister, other than an Assistant Minister, at the rate of P307,008 per annum;
- (d) the Speaker, at the rate of P307,008 per annum;
- (e) an Assistant Minister, at the rate of P255,804 per annum;
- (f) the Deputy Speaker, at the rate of P255,804 per annum;
- (g) the Leader of the Opposition, at the rate of P255,804 per annum;
- (h) the Government Whip, at the rate of P213,204 per annum;

- (i) the Opposition Whip, at the rate of P206,796 per annum; and
- (j) any other Member, at the rate of P193,812 per annum.”.
