ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation and commencement
2. Amendment of regulation 2 Cap. 43:08 (Sub. Leg.)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Trade and Industry by section 3(2) (d) of the Control of Goods, Prices and Other Charges Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

Citation and commencement **1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods (Intoxicating Liquor (Levy)) (Amendment) Regulations, 2013, and shall come into force on 1st December, 2013.

Amendment of regulation 2
Cap. 43:08
(Sub. Leg.) **2.** Regulation 2 of the Control of Goods (Intoxicating Liquor (Levy)) Regulations is amended by substituting for that regulation, the following new regulation —

- “Levy on intoxicating liquor
- 2.** A person who —
 - (a) manufactures intoxicating liquor specified in the Schedule shall pay a levy at a rate of 50 per cent on the cost of production of such goods when sold for home consumption; and
 - (b) imports intoxicating liquor specified in the Schedule shall pay a levy at a rate of 50 per cent on the value.”.
