ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Trade and Industry by section 3 of the Control of Goods, Prices and Other Charges Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods (Marking and Labelling of Halaal and Non-Halaal Meat and Meat Products) (Amendment) Regulations, 2013. Citation
2. The Control of Goods (Marking and Labelling of Halaal and Non-Halaal Meat and Meat Products) Regulations, referred to in these regulations as “the Regulations”, are amended in regulation 3 by substituting, for subregulation (2), the following new subregulation — Amendment of regulation 3 of Cap. 43:08 (Sub. Leg.)
 - (2) Any person who contravenes this regulation commits an offence and is liable —
 - (a) for a first offence, to a fine not exceeding P1000 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months, or to both; and
 - (b) for a second or subsequent offence, to a fine not exceeding P2000 or to a term not exceeding one year, or to both.”.
3. The Regulations are amended by substituting for regulation 4, the following new regulation — Amendment of the Regulations

“Selling halaal or non-halaal under false pretences

 4. Any person who offers for sale in a supermarket or chain store —
 - (a) halaal meat or meat product as non-halaal; or
 - (b) non-halaal meat or meat product as halaal, commits an offence and is liable —
 - (i) for a first offence, to a fine not exceeding P1000 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months, or to both, and
 - (ii) for a second or subsequent offence, to a fine not exceeding P2000 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year, or to both.”.
