IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Transport and Communications by section 48 (10) of the Road Traffic Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

| <p><b>1.</b> These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Limit of Alcohol) Regulations, 2013.</p> <p><b>2.</b> The limit of alcohol permissible in a specimen provided by a person charged with an offence under section 46 or section 50 (3) of the Act shall —</p> <p style="padding-left: 2em;">(a) where a person charged is a holder of a licence other than a professional driving permit, be —</p> <p style="padding-left: 4em;">(i) 50 milligrams of alcohol in 100 millilitres of blood; and</p> <p style="padding-left: 4em;">(ii) 0.22 milligrams of alcohol in 1000 millilitres of breath; or</p> <p style="padding-left: 2em;">(b) where the person charged is a holder of a professional driving permit and was driving a public service vehicle at the time of the offence, be —</p> <p style="padding-left: 4em;">(i) 25 milligrams of alcohol in 100 millilitres of blood; and</p> <p style="padding-left: 4em;">(ii) 0.11 milligrams of alcohol in 1000 millilitres of breath.</p> <p><b>3.</b> The Road Traffic (Limit of Alcohol) Regulations are hereby revoked.</p> | <p>Citation</p> <p>Prescribed amount of alcohol in blood or breath</p> <p>Revocation of S.I.
