ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Environment, Wildlife and Tourism by section 30 of the Tourism Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Tourism (Amendment) Regulations, 2013. Citation
2. The Tourism Regulations (hereinafter referred to as “the Regulations”) are amended in regulation 5 by substituting for subregulation (2) the following new subregulation — Amendment of regulation 5 of Cap. 42:09 (Sub. Leg.)  
“(2) A licence shall not be issued in respect of any premises relating to Category A, B, J and K of a tourist enterprise unless the premises to which an application relates meets the requirements set by the Committee.”.
3. Regulation 13 is amended by substituting for subregulation (1) the following new subregulation — Amendment of regulation 13 of the Regulations  
“(1) Category A, B, J and K tourist enterprises shall pay into the Tourism Industry Training Fund, a training levy of P10 per paying guest per day at such times as may be prescribed by the Committee.”.
4. Schedule I of the Regulations is amended — Amendment of Schedule I of the Regulations
  - (a) by substituting for the words “Application Form: Categories A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H & J” appearing in the first line of the Schedule, the words “Application Form: Categories A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, J & K”; and
  - (b) in paragraph 17, by —
    - (i) deleting the words “that offer game drives and other outdoor activities” which appear in category B Licence, and
    - (ii) inserting immediately after category J Licence, the following new licence category —  
“K Licence    Semi permanent mobile tented camp – an exclusive, upmarket ensuite non-participatory accommodation in a designated area for a duration not exceeding two months.”.
5. The Regulations are amended by substituting for Schedule V the following new Schedule — Amendment of Schedule V of the Regulations
