| <p>“Levy on intoxicating liquor</p> | <p>2. A person who —</p> <p>(a) manufactures intoxicating liquor specified in the Schedule shall pay a levy at a rate of 55 per cent on the cost of production of such goods when sold for home consumption; and</p> <p>(b) imports intoxicating liquor specified in the Schedule shall pay a levy at a rate of 55 per cent on the value.”.</p> |
