IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Transport and Communications by section 89 of the Civil Aviation Act and on the recommendation of the Civil Aviation Authority, the following Regulations are hereby made —

Citation **1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Civil Aviation (Aerodromes) (Amendment) Regulations, 2016.

Amendment of Cap. 71:01 (Sub. Leg.) **2.** The Civil Aviation (Aerodromes) Regulations (hereinafter referred to as “the Regulations”) are amended in regulation 2 by substituting for the definition of “vicinity”, the following new definition —

““vicinity” means a defined airspace around an aerodrome for the control of obstacles that may infringe the obstacle limitation surfaces around the aerodrome, contained within a radius of 10 000 metres from the aerodrome perimeter fence and at a height of 33 metres above ground level;”.

Amendment of regulation 130 of the Regulations **3.** Regulation 130 of the Regulations is amended by —
(a) deleting the word “en-route” wherever it appears therein;
(b) deleting the definition of “en-route obstacle”; and
(c) inserting in the correct alphabetical order, the following new definition —

“obstacle” means any building, structure or erection, which is 33 metres or more, above ground level;”.
