2. Amendment of Regulation 19

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Tertiary Education, Research Science and Technology by section 31, as read with section 4 (2) (d) of the Botswana Qualifications Authority Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Botswana Qualifications Authority (Accreditation of Learning Programmes) (Amendment), Regulations, 2017. Citation
2. Regulation 19 is amended by substituting for that regulation, the following new regulation — Amendment of Regulation 19

“Transitional provisions

19 (1) An education and training provider who has been carrying on the business or activity of education and training in general education shall within 60 months from 2nd December, 2017, comply with the provisions of these Regulations.

(2) An education and training provider who has been carrying on the business or activity of education and training in technical and vocational education and training shall within 36 months from 2nd December, 2017, comply with the provisions of these Regulations.

(3) An education and training provider who has been carrying on the business or activity of education and training in higher education shall within 36 months from 2nd December, 2017, comply with the provisions of these Regulations.
