ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

PARAGRAPH

1. Citation
2. Amendment of Fifth Schedule to Cap. 47:01

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Employment, Labour Productivity and Skills Development by section 143 (5) of the Employment Act, the following Order is hereby made —

Citation 1. This Order may be cited as the Employment (Amendment of Schedule) Order, 2018.

Amendment of Fifth Schedule to Cap. 47:01 2. The Fifth Schedule to the Employment Act is amended in paragraph 1 by substituting —

- (a) for subparagraph (1), the following new subparagraph —
“(1) The Board shall consist of 14 members appointed by the Minister of whom —
(a) three shall be independent persons who shall not represent either employers or employees;
(b) three shall represent the Government;
(c) four shall represent employers in Botswana; and
(d) four shall represent the trade union movement in Botswana.”;
- (b) for subparagraph (2), the following new subparagraph —
“(2) Before appointing a person to be a member of the Board to represent employers, the Minister shall consult the federations of employers in Botswana.”; and
- (c) for subparagraph (6), the following new subparagraph —
“(6) Before appointing a person to be a member of the Board to represent the trade union movement in Botswana, the Minister shall consult the federations of employees in Botswana.”.
