ARRANGEMENT OF BYE-LAWS

BYE-LAW

1. Citation
2. Amendment of bye-law 3 of Cap. 40:01 (Sub. Leg.)
3. Amendment of bye-law 16 of the Bye-laws
4. Insertion of Schedule

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 50 (1) of the Local Government Act, and with the approval of the Minister of Local Government and Rural Development, the Francistown City Council hereby makes the following Bye-laws –

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Francistown City Council (Day Care Centre) (Amendment) Bye-laws, 2019.

Citation

2. The Francistown City Council (Day Care Centre) Bye-laws, (hereinafter referred to as “the Bye-laws”) are amended in bye-law 3 by substituting for subbye-law (3), the following new subbye-law –

“3 (1) Where the Council is satisfied that the proposed centre meets all the requirements of these Bye-laws, it may –

- (a) on payment of P500 by an applicant register a private centre;
- (b) on payment of P250 by an applicant register a community based day care centre; or
- (c) on payment of P100 by an applicant register a non-profit making centre, and thereafter issue a registration certificate.

(2) A holder of a certificate issued under sub-bye law (1) shall apply annually for a renewal of the certificate, and pay such renewal fees as set out in the Schedule.”.

3. The Bye-laws are amended in bye-law 16 by substituting for the word “P200” appearing therein, the word “P1000”.

4. The Bye-laws are amended by inserting immediately after bye-law 16 the following new schedule –

Renewal of a registration certificate for a community based day care centre P250  
Renewal of a registration certificate for a non-profit making centre P100.”.
