11s. to 15s.	3d.
15s. 6d. to 21s.	4d.

(2) For transfer of payment from one person or office to another :
The rate of poundage specified in (1) above.

(3) *For extension of currency—*

<i>Denomination.</i>	<i>Commission.</i>
6d. to 2s. 6d.	1d.
3s. to 15s.	1½d.
15s. 6d. to 21s.	2d.

(4) For inquiry in regard to payment of a particular order : 2½d.

(5) For issue of a duplicate order : The rates of poundage specified
in (1) above.
