

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

NOTICE.

It is hereby notified that the Controller of the local Clearing Office established in the Bechuanaland Protectorate by section *two* of the Treaty of Peace Order (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation, 1920, has issued a licence under article *one* (11) of the Treaty of Peace Order, 1919, in the following terms :—

“British creditors and debtors in the Bechuanaland Protectorate may communicate in writing with their German debtors and creditors direct with regard to pre-war debts or debts arising out of pre-war transactions or contracts with the sole object of ascertaining particulars of indebtedness between the parties, provided that no proposal or suggestion is made for payment or settlement of such debts except through Clearing Offices, and that the party so communicated with retains a true copy of the communication and of the original replies and hands them to the Controller of the local Clearing Office on demand.”
