

## **BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.**

[Promulgated 26th August, 1921.]

### **PROCLAMATION**

By His Royal Highness the High Commissioner.

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Termination of the Present War (Definition) Proclamation, 1921.

Whereas by the termination of the Present War (Definition) Act 1918, His Majesty the King in Council may declare what date is to be treated as the date of the termination of the war between His Majesty and the States with which His Majesty was recently engaged in hostilities (herein after referred to as "the present war");

And whereas by Order-in-Council dated the tenth day of August, 1921, His Majesty has declared that the thirty-first day of August 1921 is to be treated as the date of such termination; that is to say the day at midnight on which the present war will end;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The thirty-first day of August 1921 shall be treated as the date of termination of the present war, and the present war shall be treated as having continued to and as having ended at midnight on that date for the purposes of any Proclamation, Regulation, or Order of the Bechuanaland Protectorate, and except where the context otherwise requires, of any provision in any contract, deed, or other instrument referring, expressly or impliedly, and in whatever form of words, to the present war.

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Termination of the Present War (Definition) Proclamation 1921.
