### PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER  
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Control  
of Livestock Industry (Amendment) Proclamation,  
1950.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Control of Livestock Industry Proclamation, 1941 (No. 67 of 1941) (hereinafter called "the principal law");

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

#### Repeal of Section 21 of Proclamation No. 67 of 1941.

1. Section *twenty-one* of the principal law is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new section:—

"21. (1) The moneys derived from the levy on cattle exported and paid into the cattle export levy fund established under the Bechuanaland Protectorate Cattle Export Levy (Amendment) Proclamation, 1937, shall be used for the general benefit of the livestock industry in the Territory.

(2) Any surplus moneys in such fund may be invested on such terms and conditions as the Resident Commissioner may decide.

~~(3) The Resident Commissioner shall appoint an Advisory Committee to advise him on all matters affecting the fund, its investment and disbursement."~~

Short Title and Commencement.

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Control of Livestock Industry (Amendment) Proclamation, 1950, and shall have force and take effect from the first day of April, 1950.
