**Preamble.**

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the fifth and sixth sections of the Order of Her Majesty in Council of the 9th of May, 1891, providing for the exercise of Her Majesty's jurisdiction in certain Territories of South Africa, which are under the protection of Her Majesty:

ORDERS IN COUNCIL.

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, by virtue and in exercise of the powers by the Foreign Jurisdiction Act, 1890, or otherwise in Her Majesty vested, is pleased by and with the advice of Her Privy Council to order, and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

**Revoking ss. 5, 6 of Order in Council of 9th May, 1891, and substituting other provisions.**

1. The fifth and sixth sections of the said Order in Council of the 9th May, 1891, are hereby revoked, but without prejudice to anything lawfully done thereunder.

2. In lieu of the sections so revoked the following two sections shall be taken to be part of the said Order, and shall be read as if they were the fifth and sixth sections thereof.<sup>1</sup>

**Commencement of Order.**

3. This Order shall be published in the Cape of Good Hope *Government Gazette*, and shall thereupon commence and come into operation; and the High Commissioner shall take such measures as he thinks proper for giving due publicity thereto within the limits of the said Order.
